### Legendary Football Alums and Program Founders Honored

This past fall Dan O'Connor, Bill Brown, and Joe Hazard were honored by the college for their key role in starting the Football Program. O'Connor, Brown, and Hazard were three classmates that had a dream to start a football program at their college. The three young men came together to layout the plan to take on the task of starting a football team. Over a two years span, they worked to plan, organize, and fundraise for what would be the start of the football club team and the foundation to the program we all played and for and support today. This undertaking was not easy, as they had to overcome many obstacles some were a bye product of starting a new organization and others were issues raised by the college administration. The three young men, along Coach Frank Petrus (SJF First Head Coach) never gave up and worked their way through the many barriers they faced. On October 2, 1971, Fisher football played its first game.

Over the last fifty (50) years the football program has worked its way to 300 wins, as a club team they won three club football national championships. As a Division III Program it has won six Empire 8 Championships, participated in the NCAA Division III Championship five times including three trips to the Elite 8 and one trip to the Final Four. The Fisher Football program has also earned the Lambert Meadowlands trophy two times as the top team in the region.

Without Brown, O'Connor and Hazard's tireless efforts and dedication to their mission we would not be able call ourselves Fisher Football Alums. Our deep gratitude will forever remain in place for these three
